4. I will not be attending.

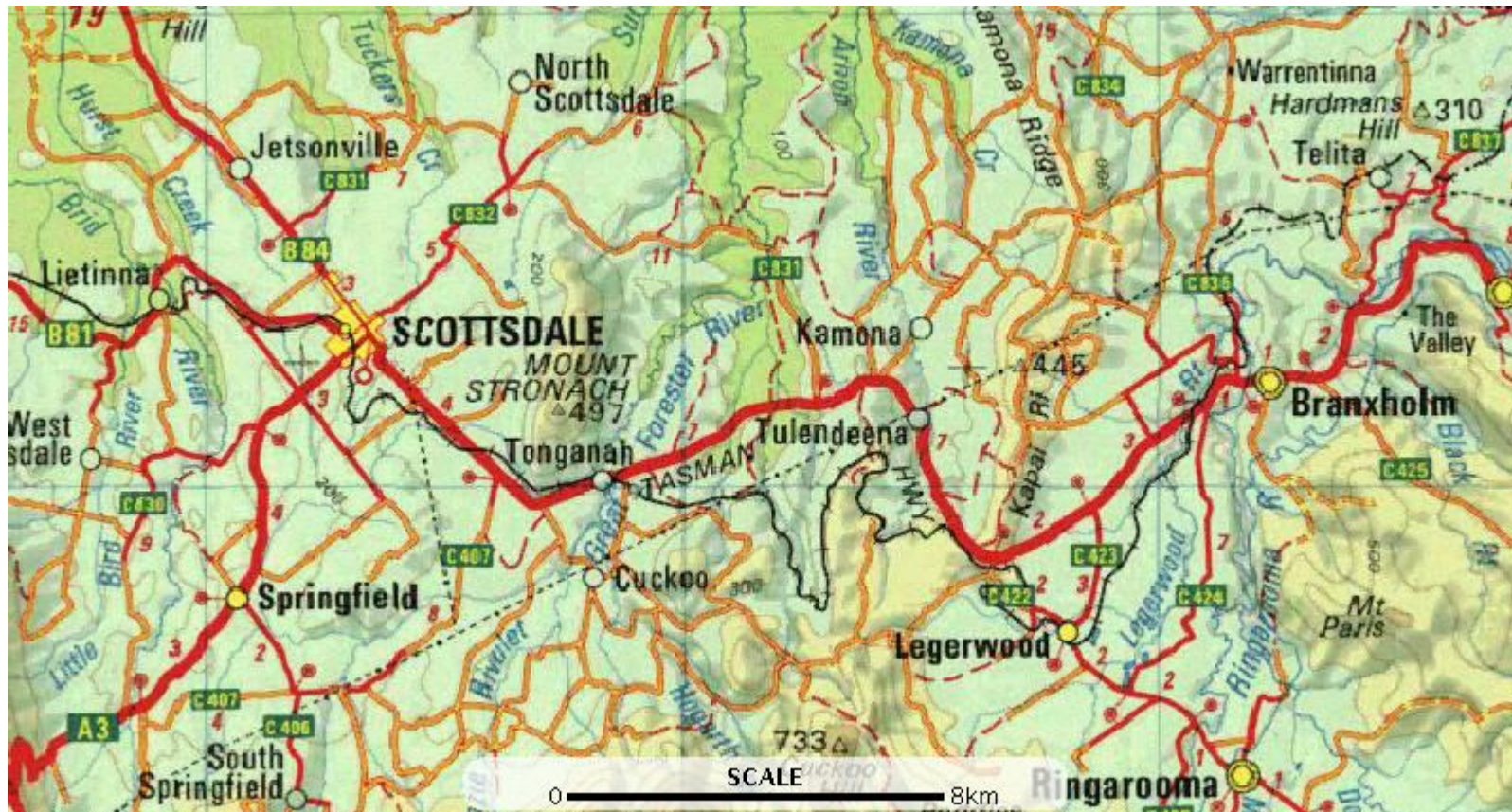
Please take the time to help us decide what you the member expect and we will make it happen, we would like your feedback in time for our next committee meeting on November 15th so that we can organise the event for you.
